



DBC Provincial Return To Dragon Boat Sub-Committees

Name

Provincial Return to Dragon Boat Sub-Committees (PRTDB-PR) shall be duly constituted committees (one per province as established) and shall operate at the pleasure of the Dragon Boat Canada/Bateau-Dragon Canada (DBC) board of directors (the board).

Core Objectives

1. To assist in the implementation of the DBC Return to Dragon Boat Guidelines
2. Support clubs and events within their specific province in determining appropriate RTDB phase
3. Liaise with the RTDB Committee

Function

The PRTDB-PR shall provide recommendations in the following areas:

- Appropriate provincial Phase of RTDB
- RTDB Guidelines

Accountability

The chairs of the PRTDB-PR may be members of the Board of Directors of DBC or Return to Dragon Boat Committee. The Board of Directors is vested with final authority in all areas of DBC Return to Dragon Boat guidelines.

Structure

The PRDB-PR's shall consist of:

- Committee Chair (appointed by the DBC Board of Directors)
- 1 representative from the DBC Board of Directors
- A minimum of 1 practicing medical professional (e.g. medical doctor, public or community health practitioner)
- 1 DBC Club Representative
- 1 DBC Member Event Representative
- This shall be ad-hoc committees

- Members will be added, as needed, when a vacancy occurs prior to the disbanding of the committees
- The Board Representative may act as the Chair of the Committee.

Operation Responsibilities:

- The Provincial Return to Dragon Boat Sub-Committees shall provide recommendations to the Board of Directors, and Return to Dragon Boat Committee
- The PRTDB-PR shall support and assist in the implementation of DBC's RTDB Guidelines
- Investigate and evaluate provincial data and standards to provide RTDB phase recommendations
- The PRTDB-PR will liaise with the RTDB Committee

Reporting

PRTDB-PRs shall meet at any time and place as determined by the PRTDB-PR Chairs as approved by the DBC Board of Directors. The PRTDB-PR shall provide minutes of meetings to the DBC office within 14 days of any and all meetings.
